Kennett Native Appointed to University of Missouri Board of Curators

JEFFERSON CITY — Sen. Rob Mayer, R-Dexter, was pleased to announce today that the Missouri Senate has approved the nomination of Kennett native Judith Haggard to the University of Missouri Board of Curators.

“Judith Haggard is eminently qualified for this esteemed position on the Board of Curators,” Mayer said. “I congratulate her on this notable achievement.”

Haggard will represent the 8th Congressional District on the Board of Curators. A University of Missouri-Columbia alumna, Haggard is a family nurse practitioner at SEMO Health Network. She has also worked as a board examiner for the Missouri Substance Abuse Examiners Board.
