Southeast Missourians Appointed to Missouri Commissions

JEFFERSON CITY — Sen. Rob Mayer, R-Dexter, was pleased to announce today that the Missouri Senate Gubernatorial Appointments Committee on Wednesday, Feb. 14, approved the appointments of 25th District residents for important state panels. They are expected to be confirmed by the full Senate this week.

Senators approved Larry Plunkett of Greenville for the Missouri Gaming Commission and Poplar Bluff resident Judith Scott for the Missouri Health and Educational Facilities Authority.

“These individuals deserve credit for their contributions to the 25th District, and I know they will represent us well on these distinguished commissions,” Barnitz said. “I lend my sincere congratulations to Mr. Plunkett and Ms. Scott.”

Plunkett is president of MPS Inc. in Greenville, a business specializing in polygraph tests. He has served as sheriff of Wayne County and with the Missouri State Highway Patrol. The Missouri Gaming Commission promotes the benefits of casino gaming in Missouri.
