Senator Jason Crowell Announces \$112,000 Grant for Scott City

Jefferson City – State Sen. Jason Crowell, R-Cape Girardeau, today announced that Scott City has been awarded a development grant from the Missouri Department of Economic Development. The \$112,000 in funding will go enable the city to provide public infrastructure improvements to the sewer and storm drainage systems.

“It is important for communities to have up-to-date wastewater treatment facilities and effective sewer systems and these improvements will help in the development of Mid-South Wire Company’s new facility,” Crowell said. “I applaud the efforts of community members because their hard work paid off.”

Mid-South Wire will create at least \$800,000 in private investment and 25 full-time jobs within two years, which will significantly improve the local and state economy.

The Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG) offers grants to small Missouri communities to improve local facilities, address critical health and safety concerns, and develop a greater capacity for growth. It offers funds for projects ranging from housing and street repairs to industrial loans and job training.
