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## Sen. Crowell Meets With MS Society Representatives

JEFFERSON CITY— Sen. Jason Crowell, R-Cape Girardeau, on February 28, 2007, welcomed to the Capitol members of the National Multiple Sclerosis Society. The National Multiple Sclerosis Society provides comprehensive services to more than 7,000 Missourians and 400,000 people nationwide.

We have over 7,000 people in Missouri with MS, but when you factor in family members that are affected the number is closer to 20,000 Missourians affected."
