Sen. Jason Crowell Meets With Southeast Missouri Red Cross

JEFFERSON CITY— Sen. Crowell (R-Cape Girardeau) on April 3, 2007, welcomed to the Capitol members of the Southeast Missouri Chapter of the American Red Cross.
