JEFFERSON CITY – Sen. Jason Crowell (R-Cape Girardeau) spoke yesterday at a special ceremony honoring the soldiers of today and yesterday. Tuesday included a series of events at the Capitol for the annual “Supporting Your Troops Salute: Past, Present, and Future.”

Sen. Crowell, chair of the Senate Pensions, Veterans' Affairs and General Laws Committee, joined Gov. Matt Blunt and other delegates in addressing the crowd on the South Lawn of the Capitol. The evening event also included a Fallen Heroes Ceremony and a performance by the Missouri Military Academy Chorus.
