Economic Development Continues

When I was elected to the Missouri State Senate in 2004, my fellow lawmakers and I made it a top priority to make improvements to Missouri's economy. working to pass legislation that does just this by encouraging companies to participate in the Missouri Quality Jobs Act, which offers incentives to companies that increase their workforce. The bill also continues the New Jobs Training Program and further develops the Enhanced Enterprise Zone Program, both of which reward job growth and economic development.

Missouri's economy is clearly on the right track. Through a combination of factors including legislative changes, new initiatives and hard work from fellow Missourians we are creating a new environment conducive to job creation from employers and entrepreneurs across the state. By making pro-job, pro-growth policies a top priority we have created opportunities for family supporting jobs for working families.
