Sen. Scott to Serve on Important Senate Committees

JEFFERSON CITY – Sen. Delbert Scott, R-Lowry City, has been assigned to serve on a number of important Senate committees during the 94th Missouri General Assembly.

The Senate president pro tem last week finished appointing legislators to Senate committees. Each state senator serves on several legislative committees specializing in certain issues.

Sen. Scott will continue to serve as chairman of the Senate Financial, Governmental Organizations and Elections Committee, which considers bills and resolutions relating to banks and banking, savings and loan associations and other financial institutions in the state. The committee also examines bills regarding the reorganization, establishment, consolidation or abolition of departments, boards, bureaus and commissions of state government, the internal operation of any state agency and the effect of federal legislation upon any state agency. Additionally, the committee considers all bills and resolutions relating to election law.

Sen. Scott will also serve on the Senate Pensions, Veterans Affairs and General Laws Committee, the Small Business, Insurance and Industrial Relations Committee, and the Senate Transportation Committee.

The president pro tem also has appointed Sen. Scott to the Senate Administration Committee, which superintends and has complete control of all financial obligations and business affairs of the senate, the assignment of offices and seats, and the supervision of certain designated employees, among other duties.

"I think these committee assignments will give the 28th Senate District a seat at the table on important issues such as improving the election process, enhancing local government and funding our veterans' homes," Scott said. "What goes on in committees is at the heart of the legislative process, so I'm looking forward to making progress on behalf of the citizens of the state."

Sen. Scott also will serve on a number of joint committees, which are comprised of members of the House and Senate, including the Joint Committee on Transportation Oversight, the Joint Committee on Legislative Research, and the Joint Committee on Public Employee Retirement.
