Sen. Goodman Elected to Number Three Post in Senate Leadership

JEFFERSON CITY — First term Senator Jack Goodman (R-Mt. Vernon) was elected earlier this week by the Senate Republican caucus to serve as Assistant Majority Floor Leader, the third ranking position on the majority leadership team in the Missouri Senate.
