Sen. Chris Koster to Lead News Conference on Immigration-Reform Bill

Group to Release Documentation Supporting Immigration-Reform Bill

WHO: Sen. Chris Koster, R-Harrisonville; Sen. Tim Green, D-St. Louis; Constitutional Law Professor Kris Kobach; other supporters.

WHAT: Progress of Sen. Koster's "Missouri Omnibus Immigration Act" (SB 348).

JEFFERSON CITY — Sen. Chris Koster, R-Harrisonville, along with constitutional law professor Kris Kobach from the University of Missouri Kansas City School of Law, will present documentation supporting the constitutionality of Koster's immigration-reform bill to media and all other interested parties on Tuesday, Feb. 6, on the third floor of the state Capitol in the Senate Lounge.

Kobach is a former White House Fellow and served as counsel and chief advisor to U.S. Attorney John Ashcroft for immigration law and border security. Kobach has gained a national reputation in the area of illegal immigration through his work with litigation regarding the prohibition of renting real property to illegal aliens in Hazleton, Penn., and Valley Park, Mo., as well as other cases of national prominence.

Sen. Koster will be joined by Sen. Tim Green, D-St. Louis, a co-sponsor of SB 348.

They will also be joined by members of The Minuteman Civil Defense Corps, a group that gained fame last year for organizing anti-illegal immigration efforts along border states by sending its own volunteers to patrol the border; prominent leaders of organized labor; and state law enforcement officials.
