AN ACT

To amend chapter 197, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to emergency services.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 197, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 197.123, to read as follows:

197.123. 1. This section may be referred to as the "Marie Van 2 Dillen Act".

- 2. The department of health and senior services shall require that each hospital providing emergency services have in place a policy for emergency treating physicians to contact the patient's primary care physician upon the patient's request and as soon as practically possible within a twelve hour period. The purpose of the consultation shall be to seek advice regarding the patient's medical history and needs that may be relevant to the medical treatment and screening of the patient. Such policy shall take into account that the consultation shall not inappropriately delay services and that it shall occur once the
- 3. The department shall promulgate rules to enforce the provisions of this section. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010, RSMo, that is created under the authority delegated in this section shall become effective only if it complies with and is subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536, RSMo, and, if applicable, section 536.028, RSMo. This section and chapter 536, RSMo, are nonseverable and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to chapter 536, RSMo, to review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently held
