PRESCRIPTION DRUGS FOR LOW INCOME SENIORS

Missouri Rx Program 1-800-375-1406

This program is designed to lower the cost of prescription drugs for seniors 65 or older with an annual income not exceeding \$19,600 or a married couple not exceeding \$26,400. Must be a Missouri resident for one year, cannot receive Medicaid pharmacy or veterans benefits or have adequate prescription drug coverage equal to or greater than Missouri Rx.

Enrollment period for 2008 was between January 1 and February 28, 2008 for those age 65 or older. Persons turning 65 in 2006 may enroll either 30 days before or after their birthday.

Coverage for the 2008 plan year begins July 1, 2008 and ends June 30, 2009.

Programs offered by pharmaceutical companies direct to qualifying seniors and persons with disabilities. Generally, the following programs are only available to people who do not have any other public or private medical coverage.

The Together Rx card provides seniors and other eligible Medicare enrollees with savings of 20 to 40 percent on more than 150 prescription medicines from leading pharmaceutical companies. The card is absolutely free and is available to an estimated 8 to 11 million Medicare beneficiaries who lack public or private drug coverage and have incomes less than \$30,000 per year (\$40,000 for couples). It is accepted at retail pharmacies across the country.

Prescription Drug Information Assistance (CLAIM) 1-800-390-3330

CLAIM assists persons needing prescription drugs to locate appropriate sources for medicines.

NOTICE REQUIRED ON UTILITY CUTOFFS

During the winter heating season, Missouri gas and electric utilities regulated by the Missouri Public Service Commission must give customers at least ten days written notice before service may be disconnected and additional written or personal contact at least 96 hours prior to disconnection. Additionally, no disconnections may occur on any day in which the temperature is forecast to be below 30 degrees.

These rules, which are in effect between Nov. 1 and March 31, require also that customers whose service is about to be cut off be told that they might qualify for financial aid to help pay their utility bills. Elderly or handicapped customers who register with utilities in advance are given even greater protection by the new rules. The Hot Weather Rule establishes a hot weather rule during the time period from June 1st to September 30th. During this time, natural gas or electricity providers are prohibited from disconnecting service to residential customers on days when either the temperature is expected to rise above 95 degrees or the heat index is expected to rise above 105 degrees for the following twenty-four hour period or on days when service personnel will not be available to reconnect service and the temperature or heat index is expected to rise above these marks.

VOTER REGISTRATION

Voting is the right and responsibility of all qualified citizens. Eligible voters are required to be at least 18 years of age, a resident of the state and a citizen of the United States.

Upon reaching 18 or moving to Missouri, anyone desiring to register to vote can do so by taking valid identification to a local registration location. This must be done by the fourth Wednesday prior to any election in order to vote in that particular election. After registering, you're eligible to vote in any election.

To obtain a list of the registration locations nearest you, contact the St. Louis County Board of Election Commissioners at (314) 615-1800. You can register at the election board office and at most libraries, city halls, division of motor vehicle offices and school district offices.


