LEGISLATIVE UPDATE FOR THE 13TH DISTRICT

SENATOR GREEN'S 2008 LEGISLATION

SB 880-Modifies laws on mental health facilities and group homes for the mentally retarded and developmentally disabled

SB 881-Establishes the drunk driving memorial sign program

<u>SB 882</u>-Allows consumers to request that a security freeze be placed on the issuance of their credit reports or credit scores by credit reporting agencies

SB 888-Requires the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education to recalculate state school aid for Riverview Gardens School District to correct an error

SB 889-Provides for mandatory minimum punishment for securities fraud crimes against the elderly or disabled

<u>SB 890</u>-Prohibits commercial inserts or other advertisements in vehicle registration notices <u>SB 891</u>-Prohibits imposition of penalties and interest on certain property tax payments

<u>SB 892</u>-Prohibits local governments from using automated photo red light enforcement systems

<u>SB 893</u>-Creates an income tax deduction for small businesses and farmers that provide health insurance coverage for employees SB 894-Creates an income tax deduction for higher education expenses

SB 926-Relating to ethics

<u>SB 927</u>-Amends law relating to the hiring of unqualified employees on public projects
