Sen. Frank Barnitz Announces Economic Incentives for RR Donnelley in Owensville

JEFFERSON CITY— Sen. Frank Barnitz (D-Lake Spring), today announced that RR Donnelly in Owensville will receive funding from the Missouri Job Development Fund through the Missouri Customized Training Program. The company will receive a total of \$35,000 to train 100 employees.

"This funding will allow RR Donnelley to pursue further opportunities and increase the productivity of the facility," said Sen. Barnitz. "I am pleased that RR Donnelly chose to pursue this opportunity to grow through this state program."

RR Donnelly is a full-service provider of print and related services, including document-based business process outsourcing. The company began the training project on September 8.

The Missouri Customized Training Program offers funding assistance to Missouri employers for the training and retraining of new and current employees. The program works to reduce businesses' training costs in order to improve productivity and create or maintain jobs in the community. Funding can be used for training costs such as curriculum development, instructional salaries, and training materials.
