Sen. Bill Stouffer Asking for Nominations of 'Missouri's Unsung Heroes'

JEFFERSON CITY – Sen. Bill Stouffer, R-Napton, today asked residents in the 21st District to submit the names of Missourians from the private sector who have achieved, accomplished or overcome something remarkable in their lives. Some of these remarkable Missourians from throughout the state will be featured in the Missouri Senate's 2009 Calendar.

"There are so many folks in the community who put their time and effort towards a good cause without any recognition," said Sen. Stouffer. "This is a way to show these important members of our community we appreciate their efforts."

The Missouri Senate produces a themed calendar each year highlighting some aspect of Missouri's history or culture. This year will be the first to include submitted entries from the public. Sen. Stouffer will select two nominees from the 21st District, and these two individuals, families, or groups will be submitted to a panel of volunteer judges who will select 12 finalists for the calendar.
