Senator Bill Stouffer Announces Assistance Coming to Higginsville Senior Center

JEFFERSON CITY – State Sen. Bill Stouffer, R-Napton, today announced that the Higginsville Senior Center, Inc., has been approved for tax credits.

The Missouri Department of Economic Development’s Neighborhood Assistance Program (NAP) has been approved for \$56,091 in tax credits.

“I’m proud that the Higginsville Senior Center will receive some financial help,” Sen. Stouffer said. “The folks at the center do a fine job. It’s good to see their hard work rewarded with a little extra boost.”

Funds from this NAP project will be directed to the Senior Center’s home-delivered and congregate meals programs for seniors, expanded youth prevention programs, and community health and wellness programs. The project will create two new jobs and help establish the Higginsville Senior Center as a comprehensive community center.
