Sen. Mayer Announces Senate Approval of Dexter Resident to State Board

JEFFERSON CITY — State Sen. Rob Mayer, R-Dexter, today announced that the Senate has approved the nomination of Dorothy "Liz" Rowland of Dexter to the Child Abuse and Neglect Review Board. The nine-member, non-partisan board provides an independent review of child abuse and neglect determinations and rulings made by the state's Division of Family Services.

"Liz Rowland has worked closely with young people as a children's church leader for more than 37 years and as a longtime camp volunteer," Sen. Mayer said. "She is a very caring individual and a nurse whose experience will serve the Child Abuse and Neglect Review Board well."

Rowland, who received her licensed practical nursing degree in 2000, is manager of the Stoddard County license bureau. Previously, she was employed as a nurse at Southern Missouri Health Care Hospital in Dexter.
