Sen. Mayer Announces Senate Approval of Portageville Resident Reappointed to State Commission

JEFFERSON CITY — State Sen. Rob Mayer, R-Dexter, today announced that the Senate has approved the nomination of James T. Frakes of Portageville to the Hazardous Waste Management Commission. The seven-member commission promotes hazardous waste recycling, reuse and reduction; adopts and modifies rules to implement the hazardous waste statutes; and holds hearings on rules, complaints and permit appeals.

"James Frakes' excellent record of service on the Hazardous Waste Management Commission makes him an obvious choice for reappointment," Sen. Mayer said. "His civic service record speaks for itself."

Frakes, who received a doctorate degree in higher and adult education from the University of Memphis in 2005, serves as the director of the Tennessee Small Business Development Center. He also holds teaching positions at the University of Memphis, Dyersburg State Community College and William Woods University.
