Senate Approves Steele Resident's Reappointment to State Board

JEFFERSON CITY — State Sen. Rob Mayer, R-Dexter, today announced that the Senate has approved the nomination of Robert F. Lawrence of Steele to the Well Installation Board. The board is a nine-member panel that adopts and amends rules and regulations to establish standards that will protect Missouri's groundwater. The body also approves education programs prepared by the Missouri Department of Natural Resources.

“Robert Lawrence’s proven record of outstanding service on the Well Installation Board since 1992 has shown him to be a worthy candidate for reappointment,” Sen. Mayer said. “I’m honored to have such an accomplished individual reside in my district.”
