Sen. Mayer Announces Senate Approval of Bloomfield Resident to State Commission

JEFFERSON CITY — State Sen. Rob Mayer, R-Dexter, today announced that the Senate has approved the nomination of James R. Tweedy of Bloomfield to the Missouri Ethics Commission. The commission is charged with enforcing any conflict of interest and lobbying laws and campaign finance disclosure laws, and is composed of six members, not more than three of whom may be of the same political party.

"James Tweedy's impressive background in civic service makes him an extremely qualified candidate for this appointment," Sen. Mayer said. "His vast experience and unmatched integrity will serve the Missouri Ethics Commission well."

Tweedy, who graduated from the University of Missouri with a bachelor's degree in agriculture economics in 1987 and a juris doctorate in 1989, works in Bloomfield operating his own law practice.
