Sen. Griesheimer Announces Reappointment Of Eureka Resident to State Board

JEFFERSON CITY — State Sen. John Griesheimer, R-Washington, today announced that the Senate has approved the reappointment of Gregory Brown of Eureka to the Missouri Fire Education Commission.

The five-member commission works with the University of Missouri Fire and Rescue Training Institute to provide firefighter training throughout the state.

"Gregory Brown is a longtime firefighter, paramedic and officer who has spent more than 20 years with the Eureka Fire Protection District of St. Louis and Jefferson Counties. His record of excellent service makes him an obvious choice for reappointment," Sen. Griesheimer said.

Brown has served as the Eureka fire chief since 1995 and was named the 2007 Missouri Fire Chief of the Year by the Firefighters Association of Missouri.
