Sen. Jason Crowell Recognizes Scott City's Championship Baseball Team

JEFFERSON CITY – Sen. Jason Crowell, R-Cape Girardeau, yesterday (8/6) applauded the efforts of the Scott City Rams baseball team, who recently won the Class 2 state championship. Sen. Crowell presented the team with a unanimously passed Senate resolution.

"These young men have proven themselves as a team and as individuals, both on the field and off," Sen. Crowell said. "I am pleased to be able to personally present this resolution and deliver my congratulations on their accomplishment."

The team earned the title of Class 2 state champion in a 13-3, six-inning victory in Springfield this May. This was the school's first state-level first place trophy in any sport.
