Sen. Jason Crowell Receives Legislative Award from Missouri Bar

JEFFERSON CITY – Sen. Jason Crowell, R-Cape Girardeau, recently received the Missouri Bar's 2008 Legislative Award for his service to the state. The Missouri Bar's annual meeting awards dinner was held on Friday, September 19.

The Missouri Bar is a statewide organization for Missouri attorneys. The Missouri Bar was created by the Supreme Court of Missouri in 1944 to develop policies and programs that improve the legal profession in the state.
