Senator Jack Goodman Re-elected to Leadership Position

JEFFERSON CITY – Senator Jack Goodman (R-Mt. Vernon) last week (11/6) was unanimously re-elected by his peers to serve as Assistant Majority Floor Leader of the Missouri Senate Majority Caucus.

"Jack is a strong voice who stands up to special interests for his district and the people of Missouri," presumptive Senate Leader Charlie Shields (R-St. Joseph) said. "His continued leadership as Assistant Majority Floor Leader will help us continue to protect taxpayers, especially in these uncertain times."
