AN ACT

To repeal section 49.292, RSMo, relating to transfers of real property to counties.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 49.292, RSMo, is repealed, to be known as section
2 49.292, to read as follows:

3 [49.292. 1. Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary,
4 the county commission of any county may reject the transfer of title
5 of real property to the county by donation or dedication if the
6 commission determines that such rejection is in the public interest
7 of the county.

8 2. No transfer of title of real property to the county
9 commission or any other political subdivision by donation or
10 dedication authorized to be recorded in the office of the recorder of
11 deeds shall be valid unless it has been proved or
12 acknowledged. The preparer of the document relating to subsection
13 1 of this section shall not submit a document to the recorder of
deeds for recording unless the acceptance thereof of the grantee
named in the document has been proved or acknowledged.]
