AN ACT

To amend chapter 208, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to public assistance for illegal immigrants.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 208, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 208.009, to read as follows:

208.009. 1. No person who is not a citizen or a permanent 2 resident of the United States or who does not possess lawful 3 immigration status shall receive state or local public assistance under 4 this chapter, except for state or local public assistance that is 5 mandated by federal law under 8 U.S.C. Section 1621.

addition to 6 2. In providing proof of other eligibility requirements, at the time of application for any state or local public 7 8 benefit, an applicant who is nineteen years of age or older shall provide 9 affirmative proof that the applicant is a citizen or a permanent resident 10 of the United States or is lawfully present in the United States. Such 11 affirmative proof shall consist of documentary evidence recognized by 12 the department of revenue when processing an application for a 13 driver's license. A state or local government agency administering public assistance benefits shall accept any identification card issued by 1415a state or local government agency, including a driver's license, to establish identity or determine eligibility for public assistance benefits 1617if the state or local government agency that issued the card has verified 18the eligibility of the applicant.

3. An applicant who cannot provide the proof required under
 this section at the time of application may alternatively sign an
 affidavit under oath, attesting to either United States citizenship or to

22classification by the United States as an alien lawfully admitted for 23permanent residence, in order to receive temporary benefits or a temporary identification document as provided in this section. The 2425affidavit shall be on or consistent with forms prepared by the state or local government agency administering the public assistance benefits 26program and shall include the applicant's Social Security number and 27an explanation of the penalties under state law for obtaining public 28assistance benefits fraudulently. 29

4. An applicant who has provided the sworn affidavit required
under subsection 4 of this section is eligible to receive temporary
public assistance program benefits as follows:

(1) For ninety days or until such time that it is determined the
applicant is not lawfully present in the United States, whichever is
earlier; or

36 (2) Indefinitely if the applicant provides a copy of a completed
37 application for a birth certificate that is pending in Missouri or some
38 other state. An extension granted under this subsection shall terminate
39 upon the applicant's receipt of a birth certificate or a determination
40 that a birth certificate does not exist because the applicant is not a
41 United States citizen.

5. Any applicant whose lawful presence in the United States is
not established under this section shall be reported to the United States
Department of Homeland Security and the United States Department
of Citizenship and Immigration Services.
