## AN ACT

To amend chapter 566, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to sex offenders in state parks, with penalty provisions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 566, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 566.152, to read as follows:

566.152. 1. Any person who has pleaded guilty or nolo

2 contendere to, or been convicted of, or been found guilty of violating

any of the provisions of this chapter or the provisions of subsection 2

4 of section 568.020, RSMo, incest; section 568.045, RSMo, endangering the

5 welfare of a child in the first degree; subsection 2 of section 568.080,

6 RSMo, use of a child in a sexual performance; section 568.090, RSMo,

7 promoting a sexual performance by a child; section 573.023, RSMo,

8 sexual exploitation of a minor; section 573.025, RSMo, promoting child

9 pornography; section 573.040, RSMo, furnishing pornographic material

10 to minors; shall not be present in or loiter within five hundred feet of

11 any designated camping area or playground located in a state park

unless the offender provides notification of his or her presence in the

13 park to the superintendent or his or her designee. Such notification

shall include the length of time that such offender intends to be present

15 within the state park.
