AN ACT

To amend chapter 209, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to real-time captioning of certain television programming.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 209, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 209.350, to read as follows:

209.350. 1. Beginning January 1, 2009, all television stations

located in the state of Missouri with gross revenues in excess of three million dollars a year shall provide real-time captioning of all local

news, weather, and sports programming. The use of electronic

5 newsroom technology shall not satisfy the requirements of this section.

6 2. All stations required to provide real-time captioning under

this section may limit their expenditures for such captioning to two

8 percent of their annual gross revenues.
