AN ACT

To amend chapter 267, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to animal identification.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 267, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 267.165, to read as follows:

267.165. 1. The department of agriculture shall not participate 2 in the National Animal Identification System administered by the 3 United States Department of Agriculture absent specific statutory 4 authorization by the general assembly for such participation.

5 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection 1 of this section, 6 nothing in this section shall be construed as prohibiting the 7 department of agriculture from participating in any Missouri voluntary 8 or private animal identification program that verifies the health of 9 Missouri livestock required for interstate export, marketing, and 10 livestock movement.

3. Any Missouri voluntary animal identification program
administered by the department of agriculture shall be subject to the
following conditions:

14 (1) The department shall provide participants all relevant15 program information;

16 (2) Program participants shall be permitted to withdraw from
17 the program at any time and have their information expunged upon
18 request;

(3) The department of agriculture shall not require participation
in a Missouri specific source verification program for cattle or for any
other species of livestock.

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4. Failure to participate in an animal identification program or the providing of services to persons who are not participants in an animal identification program shall not be deemed a crime, nor evidence of any negligence or gross negligence on the part of any livestock owner or provider of goods and services.

5. Any entity or organization, including the department of agriculture, that receives state funds for the purpose of conducting a state-sponsored activity shall not require premises identification or property identification in order to participate in such activity.

6. In any of its regulations, policies, publications, or
correspondence, the department of agriculture shall refer to "premises
identification" as "property identification".

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
