AN ACT

To repeal section 301.055, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof two new sections relating to the operation of utility vehicles, with penalty provisions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 301.055, RSMo, is repealed and two new sections

- 2 enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as sections 301.055 and 304.036, to read as
- 3 follows:

301.055. The annual registration fee for motor vehicles other than

- 2 commercial motor vehicles is:
- 4 12 horsepower and less than 24 horsepower 21.00

304.036. 1. Beginning January 1, 2009, utility vehicles may be

- 2 operated upon any highway within this state except interstate
- B highways. Any person who operates a utility vehicle on an interstate
- 4 shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a class C misdemeanor.
- 5 2. Operators of utility vehicles shall comply with the traffic
- 6 regulations of this chapter and shall observe all state traffic laws and
- 7 local ordinances regarding the rules of the road. Every person

8 operating a utility vehicle shall be granted all the rights and shall be 9 subject to all the duties applicable to the driver of any other motor 10 vehicle except as to the special regulations in this section and except 11 as to those provisions which by their nature can have no application.

- 3. Each person operating a utility vehicle on a highway in this state shall possess a valid driver's license issued pursuant to chapter 4 302, RSMo.
- 15 4. Utility vehicles shall be treated in the same manner as motor vehicles, pursuant to chapter 301, for the purposes of transfer, titling, 16 perfection of liens and encumbrances, and the collection of all taxes, 17fees, and other charges. Any utility vehicle which is to be operated 18 upon the highways of this state shall be registered with the department 19 of revenue. Application for registration shall be made to the 20department of revenue on a form as the director shall prescribe, which 21shall contain a complete description of the utility vehicle, the name and address of the owner of the utility vehicle, and any other information 2324the director shall require by rule.
- 5. A utility vehicle shall be exempt from the requirements of sections 307.350 to 307.402, RSMo, for purposes of titling and registration.
- 6. A utility vehicle shall be exempt from the requirements of sections 643.300 to 643.355, RSMo, for the purposes of titling and registration.
- 7. Every operator of a utility vehicle shall maintain financial responsibility on such vehicle in a manner consistent with chapter 303, 8SMo.
- 8. As used in this section, "utility vehicle" means any motorized vehicle not originally manufactured for distribution in the United States or for highway use within the United States, which is sixty-three inches or less in width, with an unladen dry weight of one thousand nine hundred pounds or less, traveling on four or six wheels, excluding all-terrain vehicles.
- 9. The director of the department of revenue is authorized to promulgate rules and regulations to effectuate the provisions of this section pertaining to the registration and titling of utility vehicles. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010, RSMo, that is created under the authority delegated in

45 this section shall become effective only if it complies with and is subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536, RSMo, and, if applicable, 46 section 536.028, RSMo. This section and chapter 536, RSMo, are 47nonseverable and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly 48 pursuant to chapter 536, RSMo, to review, to delay the effective date, 49 or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently held 50 unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule 51proposed or adopted after August 28, 2008, shall be invalid and void. 52
