AN ACT

To repeal section 135.903, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to rural empowerment zone criteria.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 135.903, RSMo, is repealed and one new section 2 enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 135.903, to read as follows:

135.903. 1. To qualify as a rural empowerment zone, an area shall meet all the following criteria:

- 3 (1) The area is one of pervasive poverty, unemployment, and general 4 distress;
- 5 (2) At least sixty-five percent of the population has earned income below 6 eighty percent of the median income of all residents within the state according 7 to the last decennial census or other appropriate source as approved by the 8 director;
- 9 (3) The population of the area is at least four hundred but not more than 10 three thousand five hundred at the time of designation as a rural empowerment 11 zone;
- 12 (4) The level of unemployment of persons, according to the most recent
- 13 data available from the division of employment security or from the United States
- 14 Bureau of Census and approved by the director, within the area exceeds one and
- 15 one-half times the average rate of unemployment for the state of Missouri over
- 16 the previous twelve months, or the percentage of area residents employed on a
- 17 full-time basis is less than fifty percent of the statewide percentage of residents
- 18 employed on a full-time basis;
- 19 (5) The area is situated more than ten miles from any existing rural

(6) The area is situated in [a county of the third classification without a 22 township form of government and with more than eight thousand nine hundred 23twenty-five but less than nine thousand twenty-five] any county with sixteen 24thousand or fewer inhabitants; and

- (7) The area is not situated in an existing enterprise zone.
- 26 2. The governing body of any county in which an area may be designated a rural empowerment zone shall submit to the department an application showing 27that the area complies with the requirements of subsection 1 of this section. The 28 29 department shall declare the area a rural empowerment zone if upon 30 investigation the department finds that the area meets the requirements of subsection 1 of this section. If the area is found not to meet the requirements, 31 32 the governing body shall have the opportunity to submit another application for designation as a rural empowerment zone and the department shall designate the 33 area a rural empowerment zone if upon investigation the department finds that 34 the area meets the requirements of subsection 1 of this section. 35
- 36 3. There shall be no more than two rural empowerment zones per county as created under sections 135.900 to 135.906 in existence at any time. 37
