JOINT RESOLUTION

Submitting to the qualified voters of Missouri, an amendment to article VI of the Constitution of Missouri, and adopting one new section relating to local government.

Be it resolved by the Senate, the House of Representatives concurring therein:

That at the next general election to be held in the state of Missouri, on 2 Tuesday next following the first Monday in November, 2008, or at a special 3 election to be called by the governor for that purpose, there is hereby submitted 4 to the qualified voters of this state, for adoption or rejection, the following 5 amendment to article VI of the Constitution of the state of Missouri: Section A. Article VI, Constitution of Missouri, is amended by adding one

2 new section, to be known as section 8(a), to read as follows:

Section 8(a). The governing body of any county of this state, 2 including the city of St. Louis, may adopt by ordinance or order 3 regulations affecting public health and welfare which are more 4 restrictive than state law.
