## AN ACT

To authorize the conveyance of property owned by the state of Missouri in St. Louis County, with an emergency clause.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section 1. 1. The governor is hereby authorized and empowered

- 2 to sell, transfer, grant, convey, remise, release, and forever quitclaim
- 3 all interest of the state of Missouri in real property known as
- 4 Bellefontaine in St. Louis County. The property to be conveyed is more
- 5 particularly described as follows:
- 6 A TRACT OF LAND IN UNITED STATES SURVEY 390 AND
- 7 IN FRACTIONAL SECTION 33, TOWNSHIP 47 NORTH,
- 8 RANGE 7 EAST, IN ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI; SAID
- 9 TRACT BEING MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS
- 10 FOLLOWS: COMMENCING AT THE POINT OF
- 11 INTERSECTION OF THE WESTERN LINE OF
- 12 BELLEFONTAINE ROAD, IRREGULAR WIDTH WITH THE
- 13 NORTHERN LINE BISSELL HILLS PLAT NO. 11
- 14 EXTENDED, RECORDED IN PLAT BOOK 11 PAGE 60, IN
- 15 THE ST. LOUIS COUNTY, RECORDER'S OFFICE, ST.
- 16 LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI; THENCE NORTH 05
- 17 DEGREES 42 MINUTES 00 SECONDS EAST 88.93 FEET,

18 ALONG THE WESTERN LINE OF SAID BELLEFONTAINE ROAD, TO A POINT; THENCE NORTH 07 DEGREES 22 19 MINUTES 45 SECONDS EAST 1006.47 FEET, ALONG THE 20 21 WESTERN LINE OF SAID BELLEFONTAINE ROAD, TO A POINT; THENCE ALONG A CURVE TO THE LEFT WITH 22 AN ARC LENGTH OF 596.28 FEET, AND A RADIUS OF 23 1194.00 FEET, TO A POINT; THENCE SOUTH 71 DEGREES 2425 32 MINUTES 18 SECONDS WEST 107.08 FEET, TO A POINT; THENCE ALONG A CURVE TO THE RIGHT WITH 26 AN ARC LENGTH OF 708.91 FEET, AND A RADIUS OF 27 485.00 FEET, TO A POINT; THENCE SOUTH 89 DEGREES 28 29 42 MINUTES 17 SECONDS WEST 182.32 FEET, TO A POINT; THENCE SOUTH 00 DEGREES 17 MINUTES 43 30 31 SECONDS EAST 50.00 FEET, TO THE POINT OF 32 BEGINNING OF SAID PARCEL; THENCE SOUTH 00 DEGREES 44 MINUTES 29 SECONDS EAST 307.84 FEET, 33 TO A POINT; THENCE ALONG A CURVE TO THE RIGHT 34 WITH AN ARC LENGTH OF 110.72 FEET, AND A RADIUS 35 OF 70.00 FEET, TO A POINT; THENCE SOUTH 89 36 37 DEGREES 53 MINUTES 09 SECONDS WEST 303.73 FEET, TO A POINT; THENCE ALONG A CURVE TO THE RIGHT 38 WITH AN ARC LENGTH OF 110.35 FEET, AND A RADIUS 39 40 OF 70.00 FEET, TO A POINT; THENCE NORTH 00 DEGREES 12 MINUTES 45 SECONDS EAST 306.79 FEET, 41 TO A POINT; THENCE NORTH 89 DEGREES 42 MINUTES 42 17 SECONDS EAST 443.61 FEET, TO THE POINT OF 43 BEGINNING AND CONTAINING 3.83 ACRES MORE OR 44 45 LESS.

- 2. The commissioner of administration shall set the terms and conditions for the sale as the commissioner deems reasonable. Such terms and conditions may include, but not be limited to, the number of appraisals required, the time, place, and terms of the sale.
- 3. The attorney general shall approve the form of the instrument of conveyance.

Section A. Because immediate action is necessary, section 1 of this act is

- 2 deemed necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, welfare,
- 3 peace and safety, and is hereby declared to be an emergency act within the
- 4 meaning of the constitution, and section 1 of this act shall be in full force and
- 5 effect upon its passage and approval.
