# State Senator Scott T. Rupp

## Economic Development

The bipartisan jobs bill (HB 191) passed by the General Assembly this year contains several economy-boosting measures. The legislation expands the state's successful **Quality Jobs Act**, a proven program that provides financial incentives for expanding businesses. It also expands pre-employment training through the state's job-training program.

Small businesses are set to receive much-needed tax relief under HB 191 through the phasing out of the corporate franchise tax. The **New Markets Tax Credit Program**, an economic tool that I advanced in the Legislature a few years ago, is expanded to encourage investment in small businesses located in distressed communities. Another important measure that drew much attention in the St. Louis community was the **Historic Preservation Tax Credit Program**. The program was threatened with major cuts, but was preserved with a reasonable cap.

I supported the legislation's new guidelines for **Transportation Development Districts (TDDs)**, which will require TDD board members to submit annual reports to the state auditor and for public hearings to be held before a TDD is formed in any area to bring more accountability and oversight to the process.

Another important measure of the legislation is called the *"Big Government Get Off My Back Act,"* which bans the increase in some user fees and prevents new regulations on companies with less than 25 employees for four years.

## Education

Senate Bill 291 makes sweeping reforms to our state's education system and is one of the most meaningful education bills in the last decade. I sponsored provisions in the bill that will bring more financial and educational accountability to charter schools and require school districts to have a policy on seclusion rooms and restraint methods.

Other reforms include ensuring Proposition A money (repeal of casino loss limits) goes toward schools, and removing the 5 percent growth cap on the school funding formula so that funding for schools will now grow based on need and not be artificially capped.

Other provisions include: creating a method of obtaining teacher certification for individuals to teach in the areas of banking or finan-

cial responsibility; expanding virtual classrooms; and creating a non-profit P-20 Council to build a more efficient education system for grades P (preschool) to 20 (post secondary) to adequately prepare Missouri students for entering the workforce.

Senate Bill 291 also requires each public school to develop teaching standards by June 30, 2010. According to the legislation, teachers must have students actively participate and be successful in the learning process; create forms of assessment to monitor and manage student learning; be prepared and knowledgeable of content; maintain students' on-task behavior; stay current on instructional knowledge; and act in a responsible and professional manner.

## Consumer Protection

My proposal to help consumers ward off identity theft in the case of a security breach passed in the Legislature's omnibus crime bill (House Bill 62).

My measure requires companies that own or license personal information or maintain or possess records of data containing the personal information of Missouri residents to notify affected consumers or owners or

licensees of the information of any security breach immediately following discovery of the breach.

Missourians have every right to know if their personal information has possibly been stolen. This legislation will ensure consumers are afforded more protections from this kind of disruptive, invasive and harmful criminal activity.

# FY 2010 State Budget

Despite a weakened economy, the General Assembly succeeded in passing a \$23.1 billion budget that increases funding for education at all levels. While other states' budgets are bleeding red ink, Missouri's budget was balanced without a tax increase by drawing on a nearly \$800 million reserve stockpiled over the last several years.

The FY 2010 budget contains a \$63 million increase for our state's K-12 school foundation formula while fully funding the formula for the fourth year in a row. Under this formula, funding for K-12 schools in Senate District 2 has increased 24.26 percent, with a total of \$33.3 million in increases since fiscal year 2007. Our schools are set to receive \$160 million for this school

year — a \$7.3 increase over the previous year. More than \$17 million in federal stabilization funding will go to nine school districts in District 2 over the next two years.

Another of the General Assembly's important tasks was passing a bipartisan bill (Senate Bill 313) that created two special accounts within the state treasury to place and track the estimated \$4 billion in federal economic stimulus funds coming to Missouri. The legislation was necessary for the state to accept any federal stimulus monies and it creates an accountability procedure required by the federal government for states to receive these one-time federal dollars.

## Immigration

Building upon successful anti-illegal immigration legislation I advanced last year, the General Assembly passed my legislative proposal that will prohibit public colleges and universities from awarding college financial aid to students who are unlawfully present in the United States.

The measure, included in House Bill 390, requires annual certification by junior colleges and universities that they have not enrolled illegal immigrants. In 2008, my provisions to strengthen immigration laws were passed by the General Assembly — making Missouri one of the toughest states on illegal immigration.

## Sen. Rupp's Passed Senate Bills:

- SB 126 - Prohibits life insurers from taking underwriting actions or charging different rates based upon a person's past or future lawful travel destinations unless such action is based upon sound actuarial principles.
- SB 127 - Requires the governor to issue an annual proclamation designating the first week of March as "Math, Engineering, Technology and Science (METS) Week" (incorporated into HB 506).
- SB 128 - Allows the Highways and Transportation Commission to enter into more than three design-build highway project contracts (included in HB 359).
- SB 338 - Strengthens protections for rape victims and enacts new provisions for crime victims.

## Passed House Bills Handled in Senate

- HB 257 - Allows Lincoln County to become a second classification county upon reaching the required assessed valuation and approval from the governing body.
- HB 577 - Creates a database that makes the costs of the MO HealthNet (Medicaid) program transparent.
- HB 922 - Requires each school district to adopt a policy on allergy prevention and response that also addresses potentially deadly food-borne allergies.



## Honoring Veterans & Military Members

I supported important measures passed by the Legislature to benefit active and retired military members in our state. House Bill 82 allows veterans to receive a 100 percent income tax exemption by 2016 on their military benefits, regardless of their Social Security exemption. It also removes the age requirement, allowing all Missourians receiving public retirement benefits to take part in the income tax exemption.

The Legislature also approved an omnibus military bill (House Bill 427) containing several important measures, including:

- Allowing a dependent of a military member who resides in Missouri and whose parent is assigned to a permanent duty station in Missouri to be eligible for in-state tuition at state colleges and universities, and
- Creating an interstate interchange designation program to honor fallen Missouri heroes who have been killed in action while on active duty in Afghanistan or Iraq on or after September 11, 2001.
