



Senator Scott T. Rupp Named to Council that Assists the Disabled with Telecommunications Equipment & Services

JEFFERSON CITY — Senator Scott T. Rupp, R-Wentzville, has been named to serve on the Missouri Assistive Technology Advisory Council by Senate Leader Charlie Shields, R-St. Joseph.

The assistive technology advisory council oversees a statewide telecommunications equipment distribution system that provides basic telecommunications services and adaptive telecommunications equipment to persons with disabilities.

“I am pleased to serve on the council and to foster the council’s mission to provide Missourians with disabilities the special telecommunications equipment they need to keep them in touch with family and friends and to have access to important services and emergency assistance,” Sen. Rupp said.

The advisory council meets at least four times per year and reports annually to the Governor and General Assembly.
