



Senator Scott T. Rupp to Host Informational Meeting with State Tax Commission to Answer Residents' Property Tax Questions

JEFFERSON CITY — Senator Scott T. Rupp, R-Wentzville, will be hosting a public open house with the Missouri State Tax Commission on Monday, Sept. 21, from 3 to 5 p.m. at the University of Missouri Extension Office, 880 W. College, in Troy. Commissioners and staff will be available to answer individualized questions from Lincoln County residents regarding the tax assessment rules, procedures and process of which the Lincoln County assessor must abide.

“There has been some confusion over the recent local property tax assessments in Lincoln County, so I asked the Commission to hold an open house so constituents can ask questions about their specific assessments and to learn more about the process that counties must abide by when assessing property values,” Sen. Rupp said. “I encourage the residents of Lincoln County to come to the open house if they have questions and would like a better understanding of the assessment process.”

Senator Rupp and Rep. Ed Schieffer, D-Troy, will be in attendance and several other local officials have been invited to attend.
