Next time you're trying to decide what to have for dinner, opt for baked, not fried foods. Quit smoking and increase your daily physical activity — instead of taking the elevator, take the stairs.

"By Going Red, I have made a charge to lead a healthier life," Sen. Wright-Jones said. "I hope you'll be inspired to do the same."
