## Senator Wright-Jones Appointed to New Senate Job Creation 2020 Committee

JEFFERSON CITY – Sen. Robin Wright-Jones, D-St. Louis, was recently appointed to serve on the newly-formed Senate Job Creation 2020 Committee. The committee is charged with developing a long-term strategy and plan for increasing the economic prosperity and opportunities for Missourians.

Due to term limits, Senate President Pro Tem Charlie Shields, R-St. Joseph, named only senators serving in their first term to this committee because of their potential long-term investment in the Senate and to the state.

Wright-Jones. “I look forward to serving with my fellow colleagues on this committee by working to make Missouri a place where businesses can grow and thrive and focusing on attracting new companies to our state.”
