Freshman Senator Jane Cunningham Leads Legislative Proceedings from the Senate Dais

Chesterfield Senator Guides Senate Floor Action for the First Time Following the Opening of Day's Proceedings by Lt. Governor Peter Kinder

JEFFERSON CITY — Freshman Sen. Jane Cunningham, R-Chesterfield, led a portion of the Missouri Senate's legislative proceedings yesterday (5/14) for the first time in her senatorial career and on the next-to-last day of the 2009 legislative session.

Senator Cunningham assumed the President's chair on the Senate dais following the opening of the day's proceedings by Lt. Gov. Peter Kinder, R-Cape Girardeau.

"It was my pleasure and a great honor to preside over the Senate process and debate, particularly as a freshman senator and on what is typically one of the busiest days of the legislative session," Sen. Cunningham said.

Senator Cunningham was elected to the Missouri Senate in 2008. She previously served in the Missouri House from 2000-2008.
