JEFFERSON CITY — In order to better serve her constituency, Sen. - Mark Schwieder <u>City of Ellisville and Rockwood School District</u>. Schweitzer is a teacher at the Individualized Learning Center in Rockwood and formerly owned a small business.
- Susan Haake Lueders <u>City of Chesterfield</u>. A Chesterfield resident, Lueders spent 25 years of her career at Southwestern Bell/AT&T and is currently a real estate agent with Coldwell Banker.
- **Dave Blanke** <u>Cities of Hazelwood and Florissant and Hazelwood School District</u>. Blanke is a graduate of the Hazelwood School District and is the proprietor of Artist's Concepts by Dave Blanke, which creates and frames architectural illustrations for architects, land developers, and homebuilders.

- **Dan Johnson** <u>City of Maryland Heights and Pattonville School District</u>. Johnson was elected as Councilman of Ward Three in Maryland Heights in April of 1994 and is currently serving his eighth term in that capacity.
- Chris Howard <u>City of Ballwin</u>. A resident of Ballwin for 10 years, Howard has been involved in several area organizations. In 2001, he was named president of the Ballwin Christian Academy Board, a ministry of Ballwin Baptist Church, and served in that capacity until 2004.
- **G. J. "Jim" Haven** <u>City of Town and Country</u>. Haven is a retired vice president of Ameren UE. He served Town and Country for six years as Alderman for Ward 3 from 1999 to 2004 and as a member of its board of adjustment for eight years. Jim is also a past chairman of the board of directors of the Missouri Chamber of Commerce.
- **Don Magruder** <u>City of Creve Coeur</u>. Magruder has served the community he has lived in for the past 30 years including participation on the *Personnel Appeals*, *Traffic* and *Police Committees* for the Creve Coeur City Council. He graduated from the St. Louis County and Municipal Police Academy as a reserve officer and retired from the St. Louis County Police Department in 2000.
- **Bob Saettele** and **Terry Briggs** <u>City of Bridgeton</u>. Saettele is a councilman for Bridgeton, a co-owner of Satellite Outdoor Services, and is an instructor at St. Louis Community College at Meramec. He will also provide senate liaison representation for Pattonville School District. Briggs is a government relations specialist and is also Missouri's Special Olympics chairman.
