Senator Bill Stouffer Announces Fayette Will Receive Grant Money for City Improvements

Funding Will Be Used for Wastewater Treatment Renovations

JEFFERSON CITY — State Sen. Bill Stouffer, R-Napton, says the City of <u>Fayette</u> has received a state rural sewer grant for construction of a wastewater treatment plant conversion. The \$500,000 grant will cover approximately 50 percent of the total cost of the project, with the rest consisting of other funding.

"I am pleased to see this money come into Fayette," Sen. Stouffer said. "The city's wastewater treatment plant needs these upgrades because of a growing population and aging equipment. It's good to see rural Missouri getting this help."

The <u>Missouri Department of Natural Resources</u> (DNR) is administrating the grant. Fayette city officials will soon be able to start using the funds to begin work on the project.
