Senator Rob Mayer Named Chair of Senate Education Committee

JEFFERSON CITY — State Sen. Rob Mayer, R-Dexter, was recently appointed by Senate Leader Charlie Shields, R-St. Joseph, to serve as chairman of the Senate Education Committee. This is Sen. Mayer's second consecutive term serving in this key legislative role.

Senator Mayer will lead the nine-member committee, which is responsible for funding and policy matters affecting public K-12 schools, as well as public colleges and universities.

"I re-appointed Sen. Mayer to lead our state's discussion on education because of the strong leadership he has already demonstrated in this field," said Senate Leader Charlie Shields. "Whether it's pay increases for teachers, making sure funding follows the students, or helping enhance the opportunities students have for education past high school, I believe he will continue to improve educational opportunities in our state."

Sen. Mayer will serve a two-year term.
