Senator Rob Mayer Announces Latest Winter Storm Shelter Sites

JEFFERSON CITY — State Sen. Rob Mayer, R-Dexter, is encouraging area residents who may still need food or shelter following last week's devastating ice storm to take advantage of one of several winter storm shelters that remain open and available to residents who reside in the 25th District.

"Our area utility companies, emergency management officials, local communities and volunteers are making good progress in getting power restored in our area, removing debris and opening up roadways and getting things back to normal, but we're not there yet and there are still many residents who still need a warm and safe place to stay and food to eat," Sen. Mayer said.

Last week, the president approved a request by Missouri's governor for a disaster declaration for Missouri as a result of the Jan. 26-28 winter storm. More than 2,000 people from central and southeast Missouri were staying in 35 shelters as of Jan. 30.

"The number of shelters is thankfully declining, but we still have a couple of communities without power and we still have a number of area residents who will need a warm place to stay and a hot meal.
