Senator Rob Mayer Renamed to State's Joint Committee on Education

JEFFERSON CITY — State Sen. Rob Mayer, R-Dexter, was recently renamed to the General Assembly's Joint Committee on Education by Senate Leader Charlie Shields, R-St. Joseph.

The Joint Committee on Education, comprised of seven members of the Senate and seven members of the House of Representatives, reviews and monitors the progress of education in the state's public schools and institutions of higher education.

"Senator Mayer's leadership role and longtime work in education made him a natural choice to continue to serve on this important committee that lays the foundation for an educated workforce of the future," Sen. Shields said.

Senator Mayer, who also serves as chairman of the Senate Education Committee, will serve a second two-year term on the committee.

"I am pleased to continue on this committee and to continue the crucial work of supporting quality education for all Missourians," Sen. Mayer said.

In addition, Sen. Mayer was also recently named to serve on the Joint Committee on Capital Improvements and Leases Oversight, a group representing appropriations and budget committee members from both chambers of the General Assembly that monitors capital improvement projects, state leasing agreements and the maintenance and repair of existing state buildings and facilities involving capital expenditures.
