Senator Rob Mayer Named to New Energy Committee

JEFFERSON CITY — State Sen. Rob Mayer, R-Dexter, has been named to serve on the Joint Committee on Missouri's Energy Future. The panel is charged with drafting long-term energy strategy to ensure Missourians benefit from an abundant and clean source of electricity to meet residential and business needs at an affordable rate.

"We learned from debate on several energy bills this year we have to start thinking about the future," Sen. Mayer said. "Now, we will be able to pool together ideas from people throughout the Show-Me State and have a clearer vision of where we want to be in 20, 50 or even 100 years."

The committee was created in <u>House Bill 734</u>, which was signed into law last month. The panel consists of ten members, five from the Senate and five from the House.

"Our goal is to spend the next year listening to you," Sen. Mayer said. "We have to listen to everybody on this important matter, not just those in the energy business, to make sure we have the most information to go by as we chart our course."
