Senator Rob Mayer Announces Appointment of Portageville Resident to State Agricultural Board

JEFFERSON CITY — State Sen. Rob Mayer, R-Dexter, recently announced that Steven B. Martin of Portageville has been named to the Missouri Agricultural and Small Business Development Authority.

The Missouri Agricultural and Small Business Development Authority makes capital available to Missouri farmers, particularly independent producers, agribusinesses and small businesses at competitive interest rates on a scale to make a major impact.
