A Thank You to Our Teachers

The first week in May is Teacher Appreciation Week, a time to ensure that teachers get the thanks they deserve. The week is an opportunity for our local teachers to be in the spotlight as students and parents acknowledge them for the work they do to give each child a world-class educational opportunity. Teachers are the backbone of our schools. They are the ones who teach our students the lessons that will benefit them for the rest of their lives.

We have made great strides for public education in the past, and our work continues this year. Since 2005, on the state level, we have substantially increased funding to our local K-12 schools (see chart below for district-specific funding increases). Funding education is the best investment Missouri can make in the future of our state. Currently, the budget for fiscal year 2010, which begins on July 1, 2009, contains a \$2.6 million increase for schools in Southeast Missouri. This brings this year's total state funding for our area schools to \$77.3 million, a 3.5 percent increase over the previous year.
