Sen. Jack Goodman Appointed to Missouri Tourism Commission

JEFFERSON CITY – Senator Jack Goodman (R-Mt. Vernon) was recently appointed to the Missouri Tourism Commission by Senate Leader Charlie Shields (R-St. Joseph).
