Local Company to Receive Job Training Funds

JEFFERSON CITY—Senator David Pearce (R-Warrensburg) today announced that Branaman Cabinet Incorporated in Peculiar will receive funding from the Missouri Job Development Fund for the Missouri Customized Training Program. The company will receive \$30,000 to train 30 workers.

“I’m pleased Branaman Cabinet will benefit from the Missouri Customized Training Program,” Sen. Pearce said. “A well-trained and highly skilled workforce will only better our local communities and the entire state of Missouri.”

The Missouri Customized Training program offers funding assistance to eligible Missouri employers for the training and re-training of new and existing employees. In fiscal year 2009, training assistance was approved for 243 companies and five company training consortiums to train more than 32,000 workers. These companies reported more than \$1.4 billion in capital investment in Missouri.
