Senator Chuck Purgason Announces Senate Approval of John Albright to State Commission

JEFFERSON CITY — State Sen. Chuck Purgason, R-Caulfield, today announced that the Senate Gubernatorial Appointments Committee and the full Senate have approved the nomination of John R. Albright of Sunrise Beach to the Missouri Community Service Commission.

The Missouri Community Service Commission (MCSC), located within the Missouri Department of Economic Development, strengthens Missouri communities by connecting Missourians of all ages and backgrounds to meet unmet community needs through volunteerism and service. The MCSC serves as the administrator for AmeriCorps programs in Missouri.

“John will be an excellent addition to the commission with his extensive business management and training experience,” Sen. Purgason said. “I look forward to his contributions to the commission’s important work.”

Albright is the former director of learning transfer and sustainability for U.S. Pharmaceuticals Learning and Development for Pfizer Inc., New York, and is a retired captain of the United States Navy Reserve. He is a certified trainer in a variety of community strategy, leadership and management development, behavior management, and coaching courses.

Albright, who holds a mathematics degree from Marquette University in Milwaukee, will serve for a term ending Dec. 15, 2011.
